Part A

Refer to a road map of Ontario to find the answers to the following questions. Write the answers *in complete sentences* on a piece of punched, lined paper. Do not mark this sheet in any other way.

1. Approximately how many kilometres is it from Peterborough to Ottawa?
2. In what direction will we be travelling?
3. Which highway provides the most direct route?
4. Approximately how many kilometres is it from Norwood to Havelock?
5. Approximately how many kilometres is it from Norwood to Marmora?
6. If we were to turn south at Kaladar, on which highway would we be travelling?
7. How many OPP stations are there along the highway between Peterborough and Ottawa?
8. Which multi-lane highway will we likely travel on when we get close to Ottawa?
9. Name three provincial parks found along the route between Peterborough and Ottawa.
10. If we travel at 80 km/h, approximately how long should it take us to get to Ottawa if we don't make any stops?

Part B

Make up a car rally of your own, similar to the one in Part A. Determine a starting and ending point. Ask ten questions about the route to give other Grade 7 students practice in working with a road map (direction, location, scale, and symbols).
